<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Develop and support the Research &amp; Evaluation (R&amp;E) team's capacity to access, analyse, interpret, and report quantitative data from existing and published data sources and data collected by individual Our Place sites, services providers and key stakeholders</li><li>• Engage with key stakeholders (government, partners, etc.) to support data access and collection, including preparation of data requests, data handling processes and ethics applications</li><li>• Deliver narratives that interpret and contextualise data learnings at a site level and across the organisation - in a clear, confident and timely manner</li><li>• Drive the development of high-quality quantitative data reports, visualizations and presentations</li><li>• Grow the R&amp;E team's overall research and evaluation capability by contributing to the development and implementation of new data sources, surveys or collection tools as needed</li><li>• Contribute to other research and administration tasks as required</li></ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Bachelor or higher qualifications in social sciences, data science and/or evaluation/research field</li><li>• 5 years or more relevant experience in evaluation/research in education, health or health promotion preferable.</li><li>• Experience in the implementation and analysis of applied social/evaluation research (quantitative focus) across like settings – including data collection, statistical analysis, reporting and data visualisation</li><li>• Experience working with and reporting to government stakeholders (DET, DHHS, etc.)</li><li>• Experience with the preparation of data requests, ethics applications and associated protocols required to support evaluation and research at scale</li><li>• Experience and knowledge of privacy legislation principles and policies, specifically handling sensitive and confidential information with professionalism and integrity</li></ul>	

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WORKING CONDITIONS	
<b>WORK ENVIRONMENT</b>	The role is performed primarily at the Our Place Central Office in Doveton, however, there will be a need to travel to meet with local stakeholders and to meet with other Our Place sites staff from time to time.
<b>HOURS / SHIFTS</b>	Generally, 7.6 hours per day, Fulltime (with flexibility)
